CTSI Service Center

The goal of the UF Clinical and Translational Science Institute's Service Center is to provide research services and resources to investigators performing translational research across the UF campus. The CTSI Service Center works closely with investigators, the UF Institutional Review Boards, the UF College of Medicine Research Administration and Compliance office and service providers across the CTSI and the university.

Services

The CTSI Service Center provides a range of services to research teams, including biostatistical and regulatory support, IT and data support through our CTS-IT and Research Electronic Data Capture (REDCap) teams, and facilities to conduct research through the UF Clinical Research Center. Our research navigators advise research teams on available resources and help them navigate research-related processes. Navigators are well versed in IRB application preparation, protocol development, Good Clinical Practice guidelines, and NIH research rules and standards for the design, conduct, performance, monitoring, data collection, management, analysis, and reporting of clinical trials. The CTSI Service Center also links investigators to other CTSI resources and core facilities, such as the CTSI Biorepository, UF Health Integrated Data Repository, CTSI Human Imaging Core, Southeast Center for Integrated Metabolomics, Genotyping Core, Center for Cellular Reprogramming, Center for Simulation, Safety and Advanced Learning Technologies, and Biobehavioral Core. 
